

Power

• Requires 2-AAA batteries for operation.

Temperature | Humidity

- Transmits Temperature every 58 seconds.
- Transmission icon and red LED light will flash when transmission occurs.

Reset Button

- If the sensor is not transmitting, use a pen or paper clip to press RESET button one time.
- This will reset the sensor to default settings.

Mounting

- Mount the outdoor sensor on a north-facing wall or in any well shaded area. Under an eave or deck rail is preferred.
- The maximum transmitting range to the wireless clock is over 196 feet (60 meters) in open air, not including walls.
- The mounting bracket can be attached to the wall, then the sensor clipped into the bracket.
